

Price of Attendance: 2025-2026

The cost/price of attendance for a student is an estimate of that student's expenses for the period of enrollment. Costs will vary based on the type of program the student is enrolled in such as undergraduate program or graduate program. Costs will also vary based on the individual student's living situation. Generally a student's cost of attendance is the sum of the following:

- The tuition and fees normally assessed for a student carrying the same academic workload.
- An allowance for books, supplies, transportation, and miscellaneous person expenses.
- An allowance for food and housing.

Undergraduate – Traditional Program

Books: \$1,200

Transportation: \$1,700

Other expenses:

Student living at home:

Books: \$1,200

Transportation: \$4,500

Living expense: \$5,000

Student living on own:

Books: \$1,200

Transportation: \$6,000

Other expenses:

Living expense: \$10,000

Personal: \$4,300

Fees: \$1,070

Undergraduate or Graduate – Block Program

Expenses for these two programs are “per block”, at least half time enrollment.

Student living on own:

Books: \$150

Food and Housing (Living expense): \$1,667

Transportation: \$1000

Personal expenses: \$717
