#### \$20,000 Presidential Transfer Scholarship

- Minimum college GPA of 3.6

#### \$17,000 Distinguished Transfer Scholarship

- Minimum college GPA of 3.2

#### \$15,000 Dean's Scholarship

- College GPA of 3.19 or below

Federal Supplemental Educational  
Opportunity Grant | Up to \$700

Federal TEACH Grant | Up to \$4,000

- Students who are members of Phi Theta Kappa and admitted  
prior to July 1 (fall entry) or December 1 (spring entry)

#### Legacy Award | \$1,000

- Parent, grandparent, or sibling is an alumnus or  
currently enrolled

#### Social Work Scholarships | \$2,000

- Students interested in social work

#### Veterans' Scholarship | \$1,000

- For veterans transferring directly from Kirkwood  
Community College

#### Out-of-State Grants | Up to \$3,500

- Need-based grants for out-of-state students based on  
on-campus residency

#### Mount Mercy Grant | Varied Amounts

- Need-based grants, based on FAFSA results
