Autism Program

Our autism program serves Kindergarten through 5th grade learners who have autism. Volunteer opportunities include:

Paired Play - helping learners with autism learn to play with peers. This could be playing catch with a ball or taking turns playing a game

Arts and Crafts - assisting learners cut and glue various art projects in the classroom

Whole Group or Individual Instruction - sometimes our learners need an adult nearby to help them pay attention and manipulate materials during whole group and individual instruction

Recess - recess is another opportunity to encourage learners to share toys and support learners by interacting with them on the playground

General Education

Read with Students - this would be listening to a student read 1:1 and then answer questions on the computer to test comprehension

Math - play math games with one or more learners

Shelve Books - assisting Media Secretary with returning books to the shelves in the library

Material Preparation - assist staff with cutting, laminating and sorting material

Classroom Help - assist learners 1:1, play educational games 1:1 or a small group
