Tuition Deferment Policy

- Tuition is due the first night of class unless you have tuition reimbursement.
- Students utilizing tuition reimbursement from an employer have 45 days after the last day of class before needing to pay for the course.
- If using tuition reimbursement, be sure to complete the Employment Verification Form.

Corporate Partner Scholarships

Students who are employed by one of Mount Mercy's Corporate Partners are eligible for a scholarship equaling a 10% discount on tuition. Scholarships are in addition to tuition assistance or reimbursements already provided by the employer.
