2. Consider core and major courses below as part of your requirements and/or electives toward your AAS degree. A maximum of 75 credits toward a bachelor of science in Health Care Leadership can be transferred from a two-year institution.

- To graduate from MMU, you will need a minimum 123 credits. Thus, for students transferring in 75 credit hours, a minimum of 48 credits (major, core, and elective credit) are needed to graduate.

Mount Mercy University Graduation Requirements:

- A minimum of 123 semester hours credit earned toward the degree.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 for all credits earned at Mount Mercy.
- Completion of the core curriculum requirements.
- Completion of a major program of study.
- At least 12 semester hours, above course number of 200, in the major must be completed at Mount Mercy.
- Minimum of 30 consecutive semester hours completed at Mount Mercy immediately preceding graduation.
- If graduating with a minor or endorsement, nine (9) semester hours of the minor must be taken at Mount Mercy.
