

## Northeast Iowa CC to Mount Mercy University

### Transfer Plan for Psychology

#### Associate of Arts (AA) to Bachelor of Arts (BA)

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1. **Complete your Associate of Arts Degree:** Students who transfer to Mount Mercy with an AA degree from Northeast Iowa Community College will have all Core Curriculum requirements waived except the Mercy Capstone and one course in the Ultimate Questions domain. These two requirements must be taken at Mount Mercy.

#### Credits Transferred

- MMU will transfer up to 63 credits. Students will enter Mount Mercy in junior status.
- MMU requires 123 credits to graduate. Students transferring directly from Northeast Iowa CC will take remaining 60 credits at MMU to complete the major.

- A C- or higher is required in all major courses.
