MOUNT MERCY GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS TRANSFERRING WITH A.A.S FROM KCC

- Students transferring in with an A.A.S. degree will need to complete a <u>minimum</u> 48 credit hours at Mount Mercy University to finish their Bachelor's Degree. *A total of 75 credit hours may be transferred in.*
- Total minimum credits to graduate from MMU is 123 including all transfer credit.
- Mount Mercy University core (general education) requirements will be satisfied with the exception:
 3 credit hours needed in Religion (Ultimate Question: Religious Studies)
 3 credit hours needed in Holistic Health (Holistic Health)
 3 credit hours needed in Fine Arts (Expressive Arts: Fine Arts)
 1 credit hour needed for Natural World.
 1 credit hours needed for the Mercy Capstone.
- **GPA Requirement**: A minimum 2.25 GPA in all business major coursework is required for graduation.
- **Majors must achieve a minimum grade of C- in all area specific coursework.** This requirement applies equally to any course equivalents that may be accepted by transfer from any other college/university. Please note MMU courses below. *This list is subject to change see Mount Mercy catalog for updated information.*
- > Accounting: Majors must achieve a minimum grade of C- in all major courses.
- Finance: BC 265, BC 266, BA 344, BA 379, BA 420, EC 251, EC 252, EC 366, and the upper level accounting course. Finance majors must achieve a minimum grade of C- in both finance electives as well.
- Marketing: BK 208 Principles Of Marketing, BK 305 Professional Selling, BK 310 Consumer Behavior, BK 321 Market Research, BK 431 Marketing Managementand the two required electives.
- Management: BN 204 Principles Of Management, BN 304 Human Resource Management, BN 384 Strategic Management and BN 380 Organizational Behavior) and the three required electives.
- Human Resource Management: BN 304 Human Resource Management, BN 392 Advanced Topics in Human Resource Management, BN 380 Organizational Behavior, BN 386Compensation, Benefits, and Evaluations, and BA 305 Employment Law and Labor Relations and the human resource management elective.
- > Healthcare Administration: Majors must achieve a minimum grade of C- in all major courses.
- Mount Mercy University does not have a foreign language requirement for admission or graduation.
