Intern Roles and Responsibilities:

- Attend Around the Table, hangout times, Lab classes and other events as established by the supervisor.
- Attend and participate in staff meetings, partnership meetings and volunteer interviews.
- Build relationships with the students and implement RMAs.
- Train volunteers on RMAs
- Assist with CityLife administrative work
- Completion of the Internship project*
