Administrative Opportunities

Development Committee

This committee is responsible for developing resources, fundraising and maintaining the overall strategy of our organization.

Faith Relations Committee

This committee engages the faith community in future Habitat programs, events, and build opportunities.

Family Selection Committee

This committee is responsible for selecting families best suited for Habitat homeownership based on need, ability to pay and willingness to partner.

Family Support Committee

This committee provides support for families who are in transition to homeownership.

Finance Committee

This committee provides financial oversight for the organization. Tasks include budgeting, financial planning and financial reporting.
