

Price of Attendance: 2020-2021

The cost/price of attendance for a student is an estimate of that student's expenses for the period of enrollment. Costs will vary based on the type of program the student is enrolled in such as undergraduate program or graduate program. Costs will also vary based on the individual student's living situation. Generally a student's cost of attendance is the sum of the following:

- The tuition and fees normally assessed for a student carrying the same academic workload.
- An allowance for books, supplies, transportation, and miscellaneous person expenses.
- An allowance for room and board.

Undergraduate or Graduate – Block Program

Expenses for these two programs are "per block", at least half time enrollment.

Books: \$165

Room/Board (Living expense): \$1216

Transportation: \$594

Personal expenses: \$484
