Nursing informatics students must meet admission criteria of Mount Mercy University (MMU) and University of Minnesota (UMN) School of Nursing. Students must be admitted to MMU first and then apply to UMN before April 1st (for fall) or November 1st (for spring). Students are required to pay current tuition rate of the University offering the course. If students do not take UMN courses in sequence above, they may have to take additional independent study credits to stay continuously enrolled at MMU.
