

## How do I find literature in the Wiley Online Library?

**Step One:** Select the Wiley Online Library.

**Step Two:** From the subject areas on the homepage, select “Humanities” and then “Language & Linguistics” or “Literature.”

**Step Three:** The database portal now appears. Select a subtopic of interest from the right menu. A list of associated journals will then appear.

**Step Six:** Select “How to Cite” (under the cover graphic) to see APA citing details. Select “Get PDF” from the article tools roster to see the full text.

**Step Seven:** To search across Wiley’s full holdings, select the advanced search option from the database’s homepage (left corner).

**Step Eight:** Insert search terms and select limiter from right field. Apply publishing date restrictions, if needed. Search results will indicate available texts with padlock icons. To interlibrary loan articles from Wiley, select an article title to view its full record. Select the email link, indicated by the envelope icon.
