Turn left onto 29th St NE
Turn right
Take the ramp onto I-380 N
Take exit 25 for Boyson Rd
Turn right onto Boyson Rd
Turn left at the 1st cross street onto N Center
Point Rd
Follow Stamy Rd and Kacena Rd to Hawkeye
Dr
Turn right onto Stamy Rd
Turn right onto Kacena Rd
Turn left onto Hawkeye Dr
Destination will be on the right

Bicycle 4.8 miles, 28 min

Continue straight onto Ward Ct NE
Turn right onto Elmhurst Dr NE
Turn right onto Oakland Rd NE
Turn left onto 29th St NE
Turn right onto Cedar River Trail
Turn left to stay on Cedar River Trail
Slight right to stay on Cedar River Trail
Turn left to stay on Cedar River Trail
Turn left onto Werner Ave NE
Werner Ave NE turns slightly left and
becomes Cedar River Trail
Slight right onto Cedar Valley Nature Trail
Slight right to stay on Cedar Valley Nature
Trail
Turn left onto Boyson Rd
Turn right onto Hawkeye Dr
